



Policy Document for Award of Scholarship

Aim and Objective:

Dolphin (PG) Institute of Biomedical & Natural Sciences, Manduwala, Dehra Dun (Uttarakhand) is affiliated to H.N.B. Garhwal Central University, Srinagar, Uttarakhand since August 2002.

It was established under the aegis of Dolfin Educational Society of India, New Delhi, which was registered under the Society Act XXI of 1860. Institute has been recognized by University Grant Commission (UGC) u/s 2(f) of UGC Act.

Institute is accredited by National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC), an autonomous body of UGC with B++ (Second cycle) and is approved by Indian Association of Physiotherapists (IAP) and National Council for Teachers Education (NCTE).

The institute is known for Academic Excellence, healthy standards in extracurricular activities and imparting skill based education leading to employment and entrepreneurship with an ultimate goal to create a society more worthy of human being.

Policy for Scholarship has been formulated so that more and more students are encouraged to enroll themselves for higher education and after completion they may contribute their might for the nation building.

The institute follows all the respective rules and regulations for offering Government scholarships at State and National level to all students. Apart from this the institute provides scholarships and concessions to the deserving students on the basis of their performance and merit.

This document provides clarity on the Types of Scholarships and Waivers that students have the possibility of availing depending on their candidatures.

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

To ensure that the benefits of the Policy percolates to the students unbiased and without discretion of caste, colour, creed and religion, the management of the institute has decided to constitute the scholarship committee consisting of the following:-

- 1. Principal
- 2. Two eminent academicians
- 3. Dean-Students Welfare Council
- 4. Two Senior Faculty of the Institute
- 5. Chief Admission Officer

FUNCTIONS

- All the applications received for award of scholarship under any category shall be scrutinized and processed by the members of the committee to verify the credentials and eligibility of the applicant students as per the criteria laid down in the policy document.
- Once all the committee members are satisfied beyond doubt the sanction shall accorded for the award of the scholarship to such students along with the terms and condition of the sanction for onward submission to the admission cell for necessary action.
- Any appeal or complaint received with regard to the award of scholarship shall be disposed off by the members of the committee.
- The decision of the committee shall be final for all intents and purposes.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. The students who are eligible to receive scholarship/financial support from Central Govt./State Govt. / any other Govt. Organization and/or agency shall not be entitled for scholarship from the institute under the scholarship scheme.
- 2. One student can avail the benefit of scholarship under one category only, provided such student fulfills the eligibility criteria.
- 3. The student must have qualified the class 12th examination from CBSE Board/ICSE Board/State Board under the council of Boards of School Education in India or (UG) degree from the recognized University.
- 4. The cumulative number of scholarships for all the categories as mentioned in the policy document shall not exceed 50% of the total intake of the students in any particular academic year.
- 5. In case the student is eligible for the benefit of scholarship under more than one category, such student can opt for one category only as per its own choice.
- 6. The benefit of scholarship once awarded shall be available to such student for one academic year and may continue if eligibility criteria are maintained on the basis of the result of the previous year, with at least 75% attendance in the previous academic and without any case of indiscipline.
- 7. In case the student fails to satisfy either one or both the conditions as mentioned above the benefit of scholarship shall be withdrawn immediately and if the amount of scholarship has been passed on to the student before the declaration of the result the said amount is recoverable.
- 8. The eligible students are required to submit the application every year on prescribed proforma along with self attested copies of relevant documents for consideration by the competent authority.
- 9. The originals of such relevant documents shall be produced before the competent authority as and when asked to do so. Once approval is accorded by the committee, student shall be awarded the benefit of scholarship.
- 10. In case it is found subsequently at any stage that there has been concealment, suppression, distortion or forgery of any material facts/figures/information/documents and the scholarship has been awarded on the basis of such concealment, suppression, distortion or forgery of any material facts/figures/information/documents, such student shall be liable for suitable disciplinary action as well as recovery of financial support in the form of scholarship awarded and disbursed to such student.
- 11. The decision of the scholarship committee is final and binding for all intents & purpose. No appeal what so ever shall be entertained by the scholarship committee and / or higher authority of the institute.
- 12. The scholarship committee has the right to reject any application for scholarship without assigning any reason.
- 13. The guidelines for award of scholarship embodied in the policy document are subject to addition / deletion / alteration at any time.
- 14. The scholarship committee may increase the percentile scholarship in each category as per the case and candidature.

1. SCHOLARSHIP FOR MERITORIOUS STUDENTS:

- 11. **SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Dolphin (PG) Institute awards special scholarship which shall be open for all students and shall be awarded on the following terms and conditions:
 - A written exam or personal interview (as decided by the scholarship committee) will be conducted for this.
 - The amount of scholarship shall be Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) Rs. 7500/- (Seven thousand five hundred only), Rs. 5000/-(Five thousand only).
 - Scholarship amount will be decided on the basis of the candidate's performance in the selection exam / interview.
 - Scholarship committee's decision will be final.
